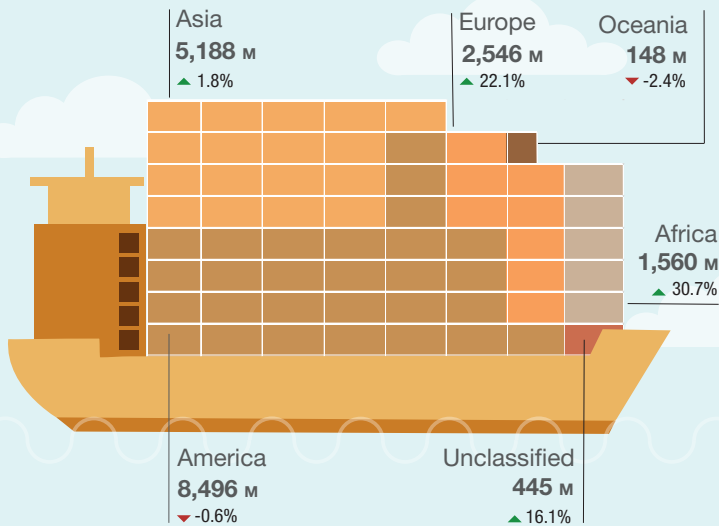

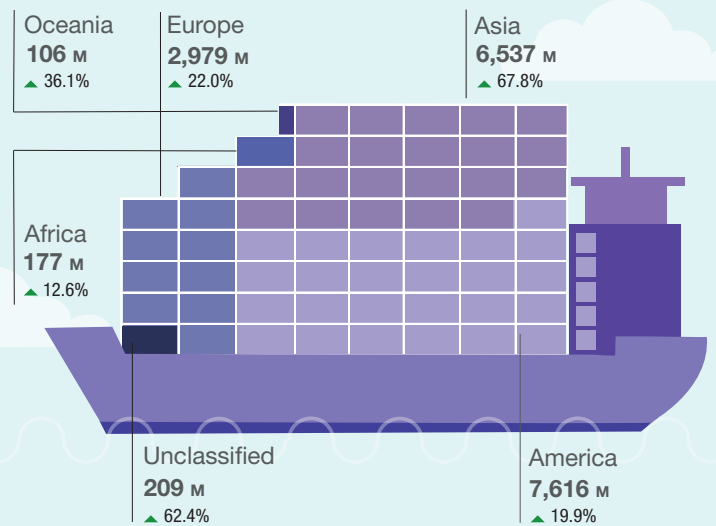

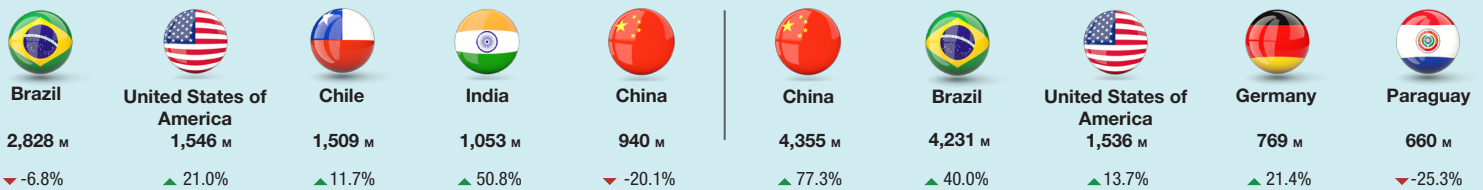

Introduction

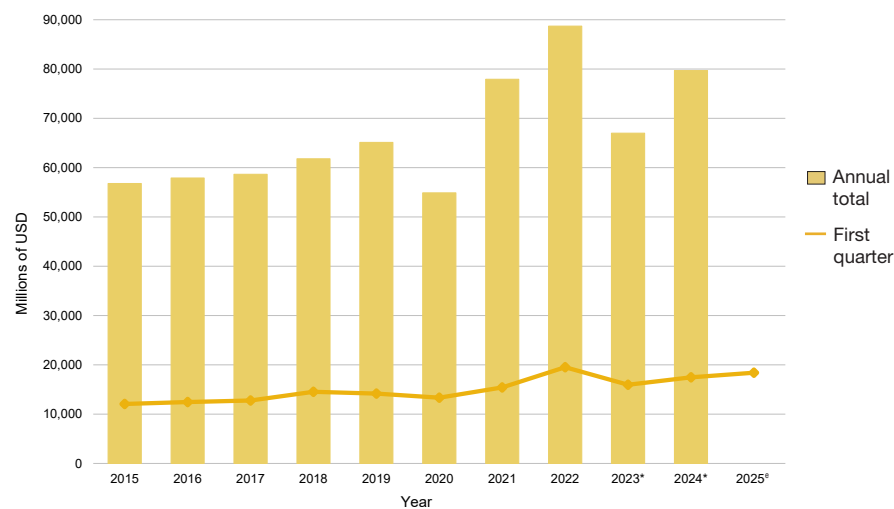
The National Institute of Statistics and Censuses (INDEC) presents the *Argentine Foreign Trade Statistics. Merchandise* publication with the aim of disseminating information on merchandise exports and imports classified by country and groups of products.

This publication has been prepared to concisely describe Argentina's foreign trade and provide up-to-date information to the global community, broken down by main economic áreas and by sections, chapters and subheadings of the Harmonized System 2022 code.

This publication is released on a quarterly basis: in February, May, August and November. This edition includes provisional data for 2024 and 2025.

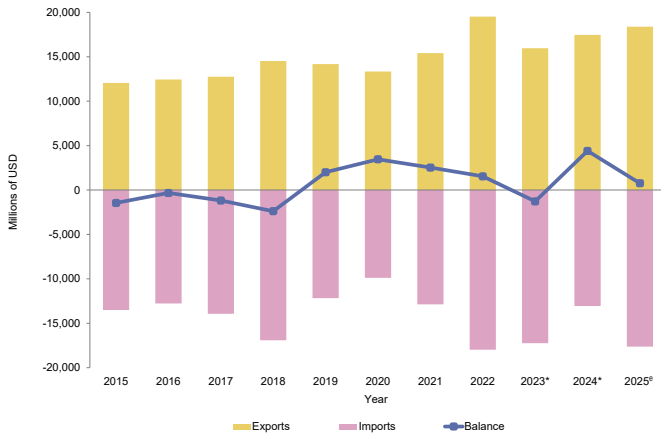

First quarter of 2025

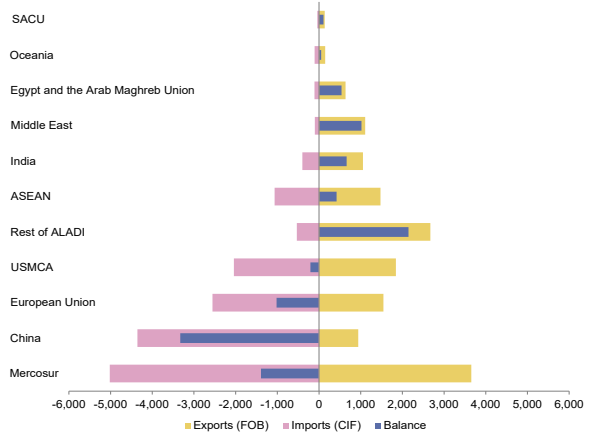
In the first quarter of 2025, Argentina's merchandise exports increased by 5.3% compared to the first quarter of 2024 and reached USD 18,383 million, while its merchandise imports increased by 35.0% and reached USD 17,623 million. The merchandise trade balance recorded a surplus of USD 761 million.

Graph 4. Merchandise trade balance by economic areas. First quarter of 2025, in millions of USD



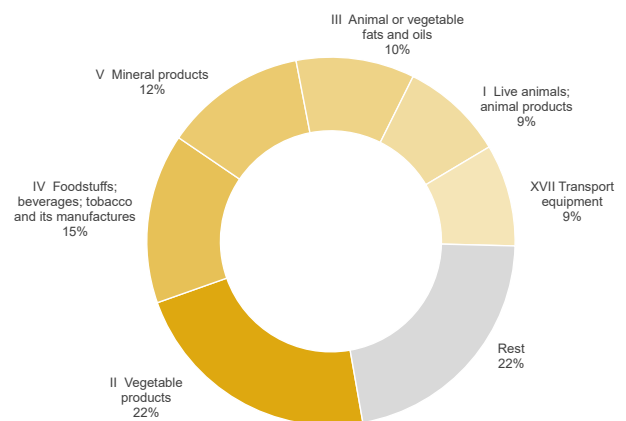
Exports profile

In the first quarter of 2025, the top five HS sections for merchandise exports were Vegetable products (section II); Foodstuffs; beverages; tobacco and its manufactures (section IV); Mineral products (section V); Animal or vegetable fats and oils (section III); and Live animals; animal products (section I); representing respectively 22%, 15%, 12%, 10% and 9% of exported goods (See Table 4).

The five largest export commodities were Oilcake and other solid residues, whether or not ground or in the form of pellets, resulting from the extraction of soya-bean oil (230400); Maize (excluding seed for sowing) (100590); Petroleum oils and oils obtained from bituminous minerals, crude (270900); Crude soya-bean oil, whether or not degummed (150710); and Wheat and meslin (excluding seed for sowing, and durum wheat) (100199) (See Table 6).

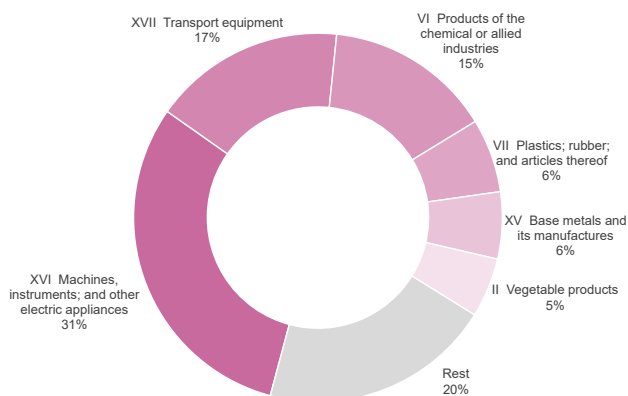
In addition, the top five destinations for merchandise exports were Brazil, Chile, United States of America, India, and China, accounting respectively for 15%, 8%, 8%, 6% and 5% of total exports (See Table 2).

Imports profile

In the first quarter of 2025, the top five HS sections for merchandise imports were Machines, instruments; and other electric appliances (section XVI); Transport equipment (section XVII); Products of the chemical or allied industries (section VI); Plastics; rubber; and articles thereof (section VII); and Base metals and its manufactures (section XV); representing respectively 31%, 17%, 15%, 6% and 6% of imported goods (See Table 4).

Moreover, some of the most-imported products include Soya beans, whether or not broken (excluding seed for sowing) (120190); Motor vehicles principally designed for the transport of <10 persons, with only spark-ignition internal combustion piston engine of a cylinder capacity > 1,000 cm³ but <= 1,500 cm³ (870322); Motor vehicles principally designed for the transport of <10 persons, of capacity > 1,500 cm³ but <= 3,000 cm³ (870323); Medium oils and preparations of petroleum or bituminous minerals, not containing biodiesel, n.e.s. (271019); and Immunological products, put up in measured doses or in forms or packings for retail sale (300215) (See Table 7).

The top five partners for merchandise imports were China, Brazil, United States of America, Germany and Paraguay accounting for 25%, 24%, 9%, 4% and 4% of total imports, respectively (See Table 2).
